She is hoping to add video now that the department has the new computer. She is hoping to have one or two more songs done by the end of the semester.

CHOIR DIRECTORS REPORT: Choir is going well. They will be finished recording their first pieces by next week and then Mr. Washington will work on editing.

WAYS AND MEANS: It has been determined that the app is the best way to purchase gift cards for the fundraiser. The cards that needed to be delivered have been by Ms. Porter. The first orders experienced some challenges and Ms. Porter is aware. For example, a credit card fee was charged to some customers who assumed the cards would be delivered to the customer's homes, but they were delivered to Ms. Porter's home.
